LOCATION – The show field is situated on the A907 between Tullibody and Stirling – the field is adjacent to the road - Entrance to the show field is from the Blackgrange roundabout.

Please note irregular class numbers. These have to coincide with main agricultural show schedule.

RING 1 - Commencing promptly at 8.30am

CLASS 137: TACK & TURNOUT – Please state section a, b or c on entry To be judged on condition and turnout

of the pony and rider, and not on conformation.

- a) Lead Rein
- b) for riders 16 years or under
- c) for riders over 16 years

Ring 1 - Commencing at approximately 9.30am

Please Note: Rider/Pony combination may only enter one class from 138, 140 and 141

CLASS 138 LEAD REIN PONY

For ponies not exceeding 14.2hh. Competitors required to walk and trot only

- a. For riders 6 years old and under.
- b. For riders over 6 years old and under 12 years old.

CLASS 139 YOUNG HANDLER

Competitors date of birth must be stated on entry form. Competitors required to walk pony, turn and lift pony's front foot. For competitors age 14 years and under.

CLASS 140 FIRST RIDDEN

Open to ponies upto 14.2hh – child 12 years and under, no lead reins. Competitors required to walk and trot as a group, and canter if possible in individual.

CLASS 141RIDDEN PONYOpen to ponies upto 14.2hh – no lead reins.
Competitors required to walk, trot and canter in figure of 8.

CLASS 142 Pony Club Pony

Open to ponies up to 14.2hh – for 25 years and under, no lead reins. Competitors required to walk, trot as a group canter as a group and do one small jump.

Ring 5 - Commencing at approximately 1.30pm – Pony Show Jumping

CLASS 143 LEAD REIN PONY

for genuine lead-rein riders only. Ponies 14.2hh and under. Very small fences!. Competitors in this class cannot compete in any other showjumping class.

CLASS 144 NURSERY NOVICE PONY

Pony not to have won more than two 1sts in any show jumping competition. Height of jumps in first round approximately 60cms.

CLASS 145 NOVICE PONY

Pony not to have won more than three 1sts in any show jumping competition. Height of jumps in first round approximately 70cms

CLASS 146 SMALL OPEN PONY Height of jumps in first round approximately 80cms

CLASS 147 OPEN PONY Height of jumps in first round approximately 90cms

RULE: HORSE/PONY SHOULD NOT BE ENTERED INTO MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE SHOWJUMPING/WORKING HUNTER CLASSES.

RING 2 – WARM-UP ARENA FOR RING 1 & 3 CLASSES ONLY

CLASS 148 FANCY DRESS Entries on the Day: £2 Meet in Ring 2 at 1.20pm. Competitors will then be escorted to the Main Ring where judging will take place. Prizes given to all! Please note item 3 on the Rule page – Hats must be worn!

RING 3 – RIDDEN CLASSES -Commencing promptly at 9am

- CLASS 149 RIDDEN MARE OR GELDING for horses exceeding 14.2hh but not 15.2hh
- CLASS 150 RIDDEN MARE OR GELDING for horses exceeding 15.2hh
- CLASS 151 RIDDEN COB
- CLASS 152 RIDING CLUB HORSE Competitors will be judged on turnout of horse and rider and will be asked to do a short show including walk, trot and canter on both legs, and include a small jump. Horses must be ridden in a snaffle bit

OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP – for 1st and 2nd places in classes 149-152 **CHAMPION:** Alloa Charity Show Perpetual Trophy and Rosettes **RESERVE:** Special Rosette

RING 5 - commencing at approximately 9.30am – Horse Show Jumping

CLASS 153 NURSERY NOVICE HORSE

Horse not to have won more than two 1sts in any show jumping competition. Height of jumps in first round approximately 70cms

CLASS 154 NOVICE HORSE

Horse not to have won more than three 1sts in any show jumping competition. Height of jumps in first round approximately 80cms

CLASS 155 SMALL OPEN HORSE

Height of jumps in first round approximately 90cms

CLASS 156 OPEN HORSE Height of jumps in first round approximately 1m

RULE: HORSE/PONY SHOULD NOT BE ENTERED INTO MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE SHOWJUMPING/WORKING HUNTER CLASSES.

RING 4 - MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (INC SHETLANDS) – Commencing promptly at 9.00am

CLASS:	MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND - In – Hand Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 Years Old and Over. This class may be split into large breeds and small breeds if numbers demand. Highland ponies may not enter this class. Special Rosette for best Shetland, to go forward to championship. *Prize for best young handler under 16 years*

CLASS 159	MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND - In Hand Filly, Colt or Gelding, 3 Years Old and Under. This class may be split into large breeds and small breeds if numbers demand. Highland ponies may not enter this class. Special Rosette for best Shetland, to go forward to championship.
CLASS:	MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Ridden, 4 years and over This class may be split into large breeds and small breeds if numbers demand. If split, large breeds will compete first. Highland ponies may not enter this class. Special Rosette for best Shetland to go forward to championship.

- CLASS 162a IN-HAND HUNTER 4 YEARS AND OVER (ANY HEIGHT
- CLASS 162b IN-HAND HUNTER 3 YEARS AND UNDER (ANY HEIGHT) Special rosette for best yearling
- CLASS 163 RIDDEN HUNTER (ANY HEIGHT)

CHAMPIONSHIP: for 1st and 2nd place in class 162 and 163 **CHAMPION:** The Lynnbank Perpetual Trophy

<u>RING 7 - HIGHLAND PONIES – commencing at approx 9.30am (after hunter classes)</u>

- CLASS 164 IN-HAND 4 YEARS AND OVER
- CLASS 165 IN-HAND 3 YEARS AND UNDER
- CLASS 166 HIGHLAND PONY RIDDEN -148cms and under 4 years and over.

CHAMPIONSHIP: for 1st and 2nd places in classes 164-166 **CHAMPION:** The Piper Cup and Rosette

Champion to go forward to Heavy Horse Championship in Clydesdale Ring BEST HIGHLAND UNDER SADDLE: Sir Allan Seaton Stewart Trophy

RING 7 – TO FOLLOW HIGHLAND CLASSES, BUT NOT BEFORE 1.00PM

Any knocks, bumps, scars etc are to be ignored. Boots are allowed and any tack is permitted except gadgets. Horse is judged on condition and musculature. Horse is also judged on it's general way of going and adaptability to it's new career. Horses must be over the age of 4 for ridden classes.

CLASS 167 EX-RACEHORSES – IN HAND

CLASS 168 EX-RACEHORSES – RIDDEN

RING 4 – TO FOLLOW M&M Classes, BUT NOT BEFORE 1PM

- CLASS 169 IN HAND VETERAN HORSE / PONY OVER 15 YEARS This class may be split by age if numbers demand.
- CLASS 170 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE / PONY 16 19 YEARS
- CLASS 171 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE / PONY 20 YEARS & OVER

CHAMPIONSHIP: for 1st and 2nd places in classes 169-171 CHAMPION: **The Billy Allan Memorial Trophy**

- CLASS: IN HAND COLOURED HORSE / PONY Open to any coloured horses of any age.

RING 10 - Commencing promptly at 8.30am

Please note: Working Hunter Ponies must be under 153cms and Working Hunter Horses must be 153cm or over

All classes will be judged on jumping ability, manners and ride/show

- CLASS 176 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY for ponies under153cms Pony/rider combination not to have won more than one 1st in any WH Pony class. Height of jumps 60cms approx.
- **CLASS 177 INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER PONY** for ponies under 153cms Height of jumps 75cms approx.
- CLASS 178 OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY for ponies under 153 cms Height of jumps 85cms approx.

CHAMPIONSHIP: for 1st and 2nd places in classes 176-178 **CHAMPION:** The Sundance Trophy

CLASS 179 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE For horses 153cms and over. Height of jumps: 80cms approx. Horse/rider combination not to have won more than one 1st in any WH class.

CLASS 180 INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER HORSE For horses 153cms and over. Height of jumps: 95cms approx.

CLASS 181 THE BHS AND STEWARTS BUILDING SUPPLIES WORKING HUNTER Jumps 3'6" approximately. For horses 153cm and over, 4 years old and over. Riders must be 18 years or over on the day of the competition. Class will be judged under "Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain" rules.

Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair Qualifier. The first three prize winners will qualify for the final of the Stewarts Building Services/British Horse Society Working Hunter Series which will be held at Blair Castle in August 2017. To be eligible for the final either the rider or the owner must be a member of the British Horse Society.

Note: A water tray may be included in the jumping course for this class. *Rosettes and final kindly sponsored by Stewarts Building Supplies.*

OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP - for 1st & 2nd places in classes 179 – 181

CHAMPION : The H. Fergusson Trophy & Rosette

RESERVE CHAMPION : Special Rosette

RULE: HORSE/PONY SHOULD NOT BE ENTERED INTO MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE SHOWJUMPING/WORKING HUNTER CLASSES.

<u>RULES</u>

(Competitors must read these rules before submitting entries, and must agree to abide by them)

- 1. The decision of the judge in each class is final.
- 2. Showjumping classes will be held under BS rules where applicable.
- 3. Horses must be at least 4 years old for ridden classes.
- 4. Competitors must be correctly dressed both when competing and when walking the courses. A hat complying with British Standards recommendations must be worn at all times when mounted, including when competing in the Fancy Dress class.
- 5. Trainers may not be worn at any time when mounted!
- 6. Competitors must come into the ring mounted and correctly dressed for prize giving.
- 7. Complaints must be handed in at the Light Horse Section secretary's caravan in writing, with a £15 deposit, immediately upon conclusion of the relevant class. The deposit will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
- 8. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 9. The committee of Stirling Agricultural Show Light Horse section reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 10. No refunds for classes withdrawn, classes may be swapped if numbers allow.
- 11. An extra £2 per class will be charged for entries on the day.
- 12. Horse/pony may not be entered into more than two consecutive Showjumping or Working Hunter Classes.









Remember: Entries close on 01 June 2017 for names to appear in the programme. After that date entries will be taken on a "first come first served" basis, and entries on the day can only be guaranteed in show jumping classes. Entry to showing classes will only be taken if places are still available.
